Approval and Cancellation of Project Measures

- Alden CARE F. Heinle handed out information his business plan for the Alden Center for an Agricultural Regional Economy ("Alden CARE") Part of the plan is for the center to be the hub for growers and producers of locally grown produce. He believes Alden's central location and direct routes to larger locations make this type of facility a perfect fit for the Alden area. They are currently looking at site on Walden Ave. which is a former industrial park.
- **RMAP-** O. Rothfuss discussed the grant Rural Micro-Enterprise Assistance Program (RMAP). He explained that this could be an opportunity for the Council to apply for a \$500,000.00 loan that we could partner with the IDA & EDA to set up a loan program that could service all the counties and the council could charge an administrative fee to help generate funds for the council. The loan program would be at or below market rate. All though the council is not in a position to support a loan program we could find an existing agency either local or regional and hire them to service these loans.
 - Motion to adopt Alden CARE as a project measure made by R. Bell, seconded by H. Kelsey and carried by those present.
 - Motion to adopt RMAP as project measure made by R. Bell, seconded by O. Rothfuss and carried by those present.
 - C. Culhane asked for Committee volunteers for RMAP R. Bell O. Rothfuss and B. Offhaus volunteered.
- Coordinator's Report J. Hovanesian presented his coordinator's report that was also sent via e-mail. The GLISTEN program was discussed in more detail and E. Mellas guest speaker from Monroe Community College explained how GLISTEN worked with the three colleges involved. RIT, MCC and SUNY Brockport. This program gives students the ability to work hands on, come back to the school and help train other students, as well as attract students to participate as volunteers and receive credits. The student currently in the program will be providing the council with a full report upon completion of their assignment.
 - J. also informed us that our area plan has been accepted and signed but has not been received back yet.
